Exceeding Expectations (4)

A #4 means that I am very good at something and that I remember to use what I know even when an adult doesn't remind me.

Meeting Expectations (3)

A #3 means that almost every time the teacher asks me to complete a task with this skill, I do it well.

Working Toward Expectations (2)

A #2 means that sometimes I need help with this.

Below Expectations (1)

A #1 means that I am just beginning to understand something.
